Winemaker Helen Masters has made the comment that the 2024 vintage was arguably the best in 45 years that Ata Rangi have been growing grapes - high praise indeed. She went on to say that this wine has a salivating, exciting quality that sets it apart from Crimson of other years and we certainly would have to agree.

"Fantastic nose - can only come from Martinborough. Red fruits, black tea, blood orange. Youthful, energetic, juicy - but with lovely structure. Seamless and approachable, but will age well. Perfect fruit, amazing tannin structure and spot on acidity. Finishes long and delicious!"

"22 years ago we named this special Pinot Noir 'Crimson' in support of Project Crimson, the charitable trust working to replant and preserve native red-flowering pōhutakawa and rātā trees throughout New Zealand. Ata Rangi founder, Clive Paton, has planted more than 75,000 trees at the Ata Rangi family's Bush Block. We continue to support conservation efforts across our region. Crimson Pinot Noir celebrates our commitment to remain in service to the land and to the ecosystem that sustains us.

An expressive nose of red fruits, with hints of pink peppercorn, hibiscus, fresh sage and rosemary. The palate opens to plush fruit, with a dash of graphite and crushed rock. The tannins are finely textured, like crisp cut velvet. **This wine has a salivating, exciting quality that sets it apart from Crimson of other years**. An all-encompassing wine that drinks beautifully now, its persistence and energy will reward those who cellar.

The 2024 vintage: arguably the best in 45 years we have been growing grapes, especially rewarding for us as organic growers, the hard work over the last 10 years evident. A wet winter was followed by drying winds and spring frosts. Fewer bunches materialised on the shoots, but a good flowering and fruit set resulted in small but fully formed bunches. A glorious summer rolled on to provide beautiful skin and tannin ripe fruit, with perfect acidity. **An excellent vintage that has materialised exciting wines with great longevity.**

Harvest — fruit was hand-harvested with the majority destemmed and a small parcel whole bunch fermented. Indigenous yeast ferment took place in stainless-steel tanks before the wine was racked off into French oak barrels for 12 months."

"**This 2024 Crimson is a spectacular wine**, arguably the finest of this cuvée which I have ever tasted and well worth seeking out as a relatively affordable entry to the stellar Ata Rangī pinot world.

Vivid crimson. This is bright and primary with elderberry and purple plum flavours which burst across the palate before peppery spice, earth and floral notes emerge on the perfumed back palate to join the blackcurrant pastille which goes right to the finish. A concentrated mid-weight pinot noir firmly in the purple fruit spectrum. It may not possess immense depth or power but there is an irresistible fruit character which is very appealing right now. Those who have the patience to cellar it will be rewarded in the mid-term with more earthy, spicy complexity as it unfolds."
