Double Gold Medal - Gilbert & Gaillard International Challenge 2025

Sometimes you just want Malbec to taste like Malbec. Ripe, juicy, soft and generous, with plenty of plum and dark berry fruit and a little vanilla in the background.

This is pretty straightforward stuff, but very easy to drink and it certainly delivers for \$14.99. It also picked up a Double Gold Medal at the 2025 Gilbert & Gaillard International Challenge, so clearly the judges found plenty to like too.

A handy red to have around for pizza, pasta, barbecues or those nights when you just want something decent in the glass without thinking too hard about it.

Winery notes (2025 Vintage)

"Brilliant deep red malbec with purple hues; fresh fruit aromas of plums, blackberries and raspberries, complemented by subtle vanilla notes. On the palate, this wine offers a sweet, silky entry with a robust structure, rounded tannins, and a generous finish."

Gilbert & Gaillard Judges Comments (2025 Vintage)

"Intense garnet colour with violet hues. The nose shows aromas of ripe red fruit such as strawberries and cherries. On the palate, young tannins still show ageing capacity. A Juicy sensation dominates the tasting. It closes with a subtle and floral finish."
