TASTING NOTES

Gold Medal & 96/100 Decanter World Wines Awards 2022

Cairanne is one of the Rhône Valley's prestigious Cru appellations, a level of wine that typically commands \$40-60 a bottle, making this Grand Réserve an exceptional find. Awarded an outstanding 96/100 Gold Medal at the Decanter World Wine Awards, the judges praised its "soft, ripe black forest compote nose," succulent blackberry fruit, silky texture, superb balance and "dangerously drinkable" character.

A beautifully crafted blend of Grenache, Mourvèdre and Syrah from mature vineyards, this is a wine of impressive depth and elegance, offering layers of dark berries, cherry, spice and supple tannins before a long, lingering finish. Perfect for steak night, slow-cooked feasts or sharing with friends, this is the kind of Rhône red that makes you wonder how a wine of this pedigree is available at such an incredible value. One sip and you'll understand exactly why Decanter scored it 96 points.
