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TASTING NOTES

Clonakilla is one of the true icons of the Australian wine scene. Since its inception, it has been one of the leading lights of the Australian cool climate wine resurgence.

"This Shiraz is made from grapes selected from five vineyards in the Hilltops district around Young on the South Western Slopes of New South Wales. Vintage 2021 was marked by a cooler than average summer punctuated by regular rainfall which slowed the ripening and gave expression to a delicious cool-climate elegance in the wine.

Mid-dark red hues with warm plum and cherry aromas woven through the region's trademark dark berry fruit."

The tannins are a firm, guiding hand to drive the medium-weighted palate long and lingering. Has many years ahead of it."
