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TASTING NOTES

Combe Rocher Reserve is a lovely affordable French Pinot Noir from the sunny Mediterranean region of Languedoc. A soft, smooth Pinot Noir with a medium body and dry flavours of fresh black plums, black cherries and spicy notes.

Winery notes (2021 Vintage)

"Deep, glossy, ruby red in colour. The wine has alluring aromas of black fruits, followed by hints of vanilla, mocha and cloves. Full and soft in the mouth with rounded, fine-grained tannins and a velvety texture.

The Combe Rocher (literally 'rocky valley') range is one of pure authenticity crafted from carefully selected terroirs, situated on high altitude slopes, with rocky soils. The terroir effect is very noticeable in this region due to the great variety of winegrowing microclimates that create an expression of the grape varieties that is unique. This specific Pinot is planted on calcareous marl vineyards with fantastic exposure to the sun."
