Coopers Creek Albariño is sourced from Doug and Delwyn Bell's vineyard in Gisborne and has been a great example and led the way for New Zealand Albariño since its very first vintage in 2011.

Winery notes (2020 Vintage)

"Albariño hails from the North West of Spain and Northern Portugal. This wine is so named because it tastes and smells as pure as the peal of a bell, and it was grown by Doug and Delwyn Bell in their vineyard just outside of Gisborne. This tank fermented wine was handpicked and whole bunch pressed to give us juice of great character and flavour. Our inputs were minimal and were all designed to preserve as much purity as we were able to do. We have only used the 'free run' juice from each pressing to craft this wine."
