On the palate the wine offers a cascade of fruit, with tempered acidity and shy tannins. It's the grain to that fruit which impresses so: primary (plum, currant and sloe) yet nuanced, too, perfumed to the last drop and with a sense of stone behind the fruit to lend it dignity and keep you coming back to the glass for more."

"Juicy, slick and vibrant expression with good doses of spice, cranberry jelly, floral lift and faint game meat characters - perfume and palate in cahoots on this.
