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TASTING NOTES

Jean-Loup Michel and his nephew Guillaume Gicqueau-Michel are passionate supporters of stainless steel for production of pure, clean and precise Chablis. Situated right in the heart of the village of Chablis, the family has been making wine since 1850.

The 25 ha vineyard spreads over the very first slopes that were discovered by Cistercian monks in the 11th century, so there's no lack of tradition. The domaine has developed a worldwide reputation for fine wine-making in stainless steel vats.

This Chablis reveals white fruit notes such as peach, and has a persistent mineral structure. In the mouth, a stony sensation which is so typical of Chablis makes this a round and pure wine.

Winery notes (2023 Vintage)

"Grapes from eight different areas are used to produce Chablis wines: the left bank of the Serein river, from Pargues to the valleys of Forêts and Vaillons are blended with the parcel just below the Montée de Tonnerre to create this authentic Chablis.

White-fleshed fruit notes including peach, with a persistent mineral backbone. On the palate, typically Chablis stony aromas characterise this pure, beautifully balanced wine.

No added yeasts, long fermentation using indigenous yeasts in temperature-controlled tanks. Spontaneous malolactic fermentation. Matured for 6 to 10 months only in stainless steel tanks with as little intervention as possible. Moderate cold stabilisation."

"This is a very fine, precise Chablis showing good density, crystalline citrus notes on the palate, a lick of minerality to finish. The Louis Michel philosophy of aiming to express all the terroir influence is very well shown here."

"Pale lemon yellow. A clear crisp very typical Chablis nose, though perhaps more on fruit than minerals. Lively on the palate with medium plus length, a touch of fresh citrus but not high in acidity. Give it one year in bottle."
