Barossa Shiraz. \$14.99. Enough Said.

Sometimes you find a wine that is simply ridiculous value. This is one of them.

The Earthworks range comes from the Hill Smith family, the people behind Yalumba, so there is plenty of Barossa winemaking pedigree behind this very easygoing Shiraz. And easygoing is exactly the point. This is not a wine for the cellar or for overthinking. It is made to be opened, poured and enjoyed.

Ripe dark fruits, plum and blackberry meet warming spice and a touch of dark chocolate. Juicy, silky and beautifully smooth, with soft tannins and just enough freshness to keep it lively. A seriously easy drinking Barossa Shiraz.

Backed by the Hill Smith family and already drinking beautifully, this is Barossa Shiraz with plenty of pedigree at just \$14.99. **Great value, great drinking.**

Winery notes

"Great wine starts with great soil, and great soil starts with those who know how to work it. When a group of local families decided to bring their grapes - and over 230 years of winegrowing expertise - together, something very special was born. Founded by families and grown across generations, harvesting the benefits of individual wine wisdom - there's more to this drop than meets the eye. One only need scratch the surface and discover the stories underneath. Dig a little deeper, and discover earthworks.

Aromas of plums and dark fruits with vanilla, cinnamon and clove are entwined with a touch of black tea, bay leaf and blackcurrants. Juicy, fresh and vibrant red fruits, fine, soft tannins and velvety texture.

Shiraz grapes sourced from our Barossa growers are carefully destemmed and crushed into fermenters, where they are gently macerated. Cool fermentation temperatures enhance the rich and generous fruit flavours and soft tannins enjoyed in this Shiraz, while the influence of French oak adds subtle spice and depth."
