We have just landed the new 2025 vintage, but still on the same fantastic deal price, which means Elephant Hill Chardonnay remains one of the standout value buys in the shop.

This special pricing won't last much longer, so it's well worth stocking up while the opportunity is here.

Elephant Hill is recognised as one of the star wineries in the Hawkes Bay gaining recognition and accolades for many of their wines. The new vintage Elephant Hill Chardonnay 2025 another fantastic offering, showing fantastic presence, length, balance and texture. It has a fruit purity at its core but it is very much a multi-layered Chardonnay with well-judged savoury elements.

Winery notes (2025 Vintage)

"Predominantly coastally grown, cool climate fruit from our SEA vineyard, blended with warmer inland fruit from our EARTH and STONE vineyards creating the perfect balance and tension of ripeness and roundness, with freshness and bright acidity.

This wine was fermented in barrel and tank, and aged on full lees for 11 months with 20% new French oak before being

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blended to tank where it rested on light lees for a further 6 months."

"Pristine, fresh, youthful, varietal and generous, a bouquet and palate of fresh white and yellow peaches, sweet grapefruit, a layer of fine lees and judicious use of oak. Delicious, fresh and ready for Spring and Summer 2026 through 2031."
