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TASTING NOTES

An absolute delight, this classic Mosel Riesling is refreshing and lighter-bodied with plenty of interest. That Mosel minerality comes through effortlessly with all kinds of delicate fruit and a whiff of sweetness that disappears on the finish. Gorgeous with or without food, this is a pedigree Kabinnett to drink now or cellar.

The Haag family has been in wine for just a little while - since 1605, to be precise - and over that time they have been instrumental in the development of Brauneberger, an area that has been recognised as one of the Mosel's best since the sixth century. At the helm today is the youthful Oliver Haag, whose father Wilhelm (son of Fritz) became recognised as a Riesling world leader, awarded the deceptively simple title of Winegrower of the Year in 1994. Oliver himself has at his back a full oenological training as well as extensive experience with a number of leading Riesling producers. With results so superb they effectively define a modern classic style of Mosel Riesling, it seems clear that the Haag family's future in wine may be as sure as it's past.
