This density creates natural competition among the vines, reducing vigour, promoting root structure and intensity of flavour. It also means that the vineyard only produces 'one bottle of Clayvin Pinot Noir per vine'.

This Single Vineyard Clayvin Pinot Noir is earthy, with wild strawberry and red cherry. It's restrained with good intensity and a structured foundation, finishing with great length. World renowned vineyard 'Clayvin' has historically set the standard for premium Pinot Noir and Chardonnay production from Marlborough."
