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TASTING NOTES

This year's blend is predominantly Syrah, followed by Pinot Noir, Chenin Blanc and Pinot Gris - making for a fuller-bodied wine than the previous vintage, though still juicy, vibrant and moreish.

Winery notes (2025 Vintage)

"Introducing the 2025 Kuratea — translating to *“light red”* in Te Reo Māori. This vibrant and playful blend brings together Hawkes Bay Syrah based wine with skin fermented Pinot Gris, Pinot Noir and Chenin Blanc.

The result is a wine bursting with bright berry fruit and spice. It's fresh, structured, and deliciously moreish — a true crowd-pleaser. Best enjoyed lightly chilled, Kuratea is an ideal companion for warm days and shared tables. Pair it with summer salads, grilled vegetables, or a chilled charcuterie board to highlight its vibrant, refreshing character."

"Kuratea translates to *light red* in te Reo Maori, a fitting title for this wine as it is exactly that, but more. Very bright and youthful, fleshy red berry scents then perfumes of white and red flowers and a gentle savoury earthy quality. Made with Syrah, Pinot Noir, Chenin Blanc and Pinot Gris the palate is filled with flavours of boysenberry and plum, raspberry and black currant, there's a baked tree fruit and citrus peel idea as the wine opens out and warms on the palate. Crisp and fine with acidity and fine fruit tannins adding texture and length. A lovely option for early Spring imbibing with or without food. Best from day of purchase through 2029."

"Chilled Pinot Noir is not only a description of the style of wine but also the low tannins in this medium bodied red, which

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make this wine suitable for drinking at a lower temperature. This is a vibrant, juicy and deliciously balanced red made entirely from Pinot Noir grapes from the slightly challenging 2023 vintage in which Cyclone Gabrielle made for difficult conditions, despite which, this wine is a great expression of Pinot Noir. It contains 11.5% alcohol as a reflection of harvest dates and winemaking but the wine is entirely dry. It's made from old vine 10/5 (25% whole bunch with gentle pump overs) and new plantings of Abel clone Pinot Noir, all grown at the Stad_Ko Vineyard (the new name for the old Arapai Vineyard). Delicious."
