TASTING NOTES

Winery notes (2022 Vintage)

"This wine has lifted lemon and floral aromatics. The palate is dry and zesty with bright acidity, an elegant palate and a mouthwatering minerality. Alongside the lemon curd character sit nectarine and honey. Crisp acidity is balanced by a touch of sweetness

This is a single vineyard wine produced from just one pick from our Waihōpai block in Marlborough’s Southern Valleys. The 2022 vintage was perfect for Riesling, allowing us to pick at the optimal time, thereby maximising the intense flavours and gaining a touch of richness (apricot and honey notes) from some noble rot.

Picked in the cool of the early morning, the grapes were gently pressed with only the free-run juice fermented to make this wine. Cultured yeast is added to the juice and then it is fermented at low temperatures (10-12C) to retain the natural bright fruit aromatics."
