TASTING NOTES

This vineyard is located in the Queensberry sub-region near Luggat at the head of Lake Dunstan. The gravelly soils give the wine a mineral character which winemaker Sarah-Kate described as 'blackberry on a dusty road'. Sinewy and fine and a wine that seems to be a bit of a sleeper to watch develop over a few years in the bottle.

Winery notes (2022 Vintage)

"From the Poison Creek Vineyard in Queensberry / 280m elevation / planted in 2003. The name refers to the pure mountain stream that provides the water vital to the growth of this vineyard planted on an ancient and very free draining river terrace. Clone 5 / 36% whole cluster / 23 days maceration - perhaps the most refined of the 4 single vineyard Pinot Noirs. Inky, blackcurrant vine and violet aromas - a sinewy and structural frame with remarkable line and length."
