This is such a good Pinot! The quality of fruit from Dominic Mondillo's prized Bendigo vineyard has given a Pinot Noir that is bursting with dark cherry and savoury flavours. Full and velvety in the mouth this is absolutely delicious. Outstanding for less than \$40!

"Deeply coloured with a sweet fragrance and a spicy nut bouquet. Generous ripe cherry, boysenberry and dark plum flavours with finely integrated oak. This vintage is beautifully balanced with a smooth velvety richness. The fruit was hand harvested in March 2022, 100% de-stemmed followed by a long cold maceration, fermented slowly and gently pressed. This wine has been filtered, is unfined and aged in French oak barriques, of which 25% were new, for 11 months. Serve with beef, stuffed eggplant, rich tomato/mushroom based recipes, pork, lamb or pizza!"
