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TASTING NOTES

Producer of the Year - Susie & Peter New Zealand Wines of the Year 2026

Pegasus Bay are no strangers to glowing praise, but they are particularly chuffed about a recent accolade they received being named PRODUCER OF THE YEAR in Susie & Peter's NZ WINES OF THE YEAR 2026.

For those of you that don't know Susie & Peter, they are both UK based MW's and have a very popular podcast called [Wine Blast](#). They tasted through over 200 wines from NZ's best producers to assemble the list. [See the list here](#).

Only made in exceptional years, the Maestro is a highly sort after wine that sells out quickly on every release. It is a wine of depth and character with layers of flavours and will rank as one of Pegasus Bay's great Maestro releases.

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Winery notes (2020 Vintage)

"It has an alluring deep purple tone. The nose is a volley of dark, earthy, and savoury notes, meshed on a lavish and complex canvas. Black forest fruit, mushroom, aged soy, and smoked game, bolstered with hints of liquorice, mixed spice, eucalyptus, and a whisp of tree moss. The palate is rugged and coiled, showcasing bold tannins and exhilarating acidity that converge to create a formidable backbone. Decadent fruit weight and impressive concentration play the perfect support role, giving balance and harmony, ensuring the wine remains expansive and richly textured throughout its sustained and lasting finish.

Maestro is part of our reserve series and represents the very best of our Bordeaux fruit. As with all our reserves, this celebrated claret style wine is only made in exceptional years. After being picked in mid-April, the grapes began fermentation naturally in stainless steel tanks. During this process the juice was regularly drained and sprayed back over the cap of floating grape skins (rather than plunging), to ensure a perfect tannin balance was extracted from the fruit. The wine was then gently pressed off and put into French oak barriques (approx. 50% new). The following summer, when the weather warmed, it underwent a natural malo-lactic (secondary) fermentation. After maturing in oak for 2 years, a selection from the best barrels was carefully blended to produce the most balanced yet complex wine possible. The finished product is a blend of approximately 45% Merlot, 40% Malbec, and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon."

"Fabulous bouquet and palate with texture and weight, complexity and style, there's a classic Peg-Bay signature of soil and barrel spice inputs and impacts. Dark berries and bitter chocolate, blackcurrant and smoky wood spices. Dry, weighty and lengthy with complexity and charm, length and youth. Poised for ageing still with best drinking from 2028 through 2038+."

"Full, deep purple with a ruby core, slightly lighter on the rim. The nose is full and complex, with savoury aromas of mushroom, forest floor, black plum, cassis, blackcurrant vine, cedar, spice and game. Full-bodied, aromas of black plum, cassis and blackberry are fresh, entwined with mushroom, forest floor and dark minerals, unfolding blackcurrant vine, star anise, liquorice and cedar. Fine-grained, opulent tannins generously coated the palate and unveiled rich herbs and stony minerals. Enlivening acidity carries pure fruit, weight and layers with elegance and vitality. A masterpiece. Match with Tomahawk and braised short ribs over the next 12+ years. Maestro is only produced in exceptional vintages. A blend of 45% Merlot, 40% Malbec and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, fermented in stainless steel tanks, pressed into French oak barriques for 2 years, approx 50% new."

"Deep crimson with aromas of blackberry, dark cherry and dark berry fruits with hints of smoky wood spice, roasting meats, brown spices, turned earth, cedar and dark chocolate nibs. Fruit-pure with earth, a roll of black fruit, a rush of dried herbs and fine, powdered riverstone tannins. Finishes savoury and as dry as a bone."
