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TASTING NOTES

Poggio Anima Lilith is 100% Primitvo from Puglia, known as the 'heel' of Itlay. The vines are 30 years old and grown on solis of rocky volcanic origin with limestone, red sands and red clay. 9 months in 10% new French barrique.

Poggio Anima is a new label for Vino Fino, but based on the quality to price ratio of these wine, we think they may become a go to for many of our customers wishing to experience some tasty Italian wines. Offering plenty of drinkability, in a way that only the Italians seem to manage, these wines offer something different to have with your next hearty meal, be it pizza, pasta or anything else the Italians seem to have mastered! And whilst you're enjoying the meal be sure to check out the labels, these wines attract as much attention for what's on the label as what's in the bottle.

Winery notes (2021 Vintage)

"According to Hebrew texts, Lilith was the first wife of Adam. She was banished from the Garden of Eden when she refused to make herself subservient to Adam's sexual requests. When she was cast out of the Garden, she was made into a demon, and Adam was given a second wife, Eve, who was fashioned from his rib to ensure her obedience to her man. Where Adam was created from dust, Lilith was created from filth and sediment.

Primitivo refuses to be submissive to the oenology that it is the same grape as its close relative Zinfandel. Many subscribe to this idea, though they are both mutations of Crljenak, a Croatian varietal. Primitivo always brings plenty of flesh and ripeness



to the table with a solid spine of certainty and structure.

Delicious and straightforward, this vibrant wine conveys aromas of wild berry and a whiff of clove. The savoury, easy-drinking palate doles out juicy black cherry, crushed raspberry and a hint of black pepper alongside supple tannins. This is simply delicious and conveys images of California Zinfandel."
