Double Gold - New Zealand International Wine Show 2025

Double Gold Medal, 95 points and #2 in Cuisine is impressive recognition for this delicious Hawkes Bay Albariño. A firm staff favourite, this versatile \$20 white should definitely be on your radar, especially if you haven't tried the magic of Albariño before!

The popularity of Albariño is ever increasing, with its salivating freshness making it perfect for seafood - this example is a beauty and highly recommended by us and the wine critics.

Grown in the Bridge Pa Triangle sub-region of Hawkes Bay. Fermentation in both stainless steel tanks and old French oak barrels, and post fermentation the wine was kept on yeast lees, with periodic stirring to introduce complexity and texture. The resulting wine has some nice texture to balance the crisp, fresh notes.

Winery notes (2025 Vintage)

"The Advocate Albariño is grown in the Bridge Pa Triangle sub-region of Hawke's Bay. Warm temperatures and free draining silt over red metal gravels provide perfect growing conditions.

Fruit for this wine is harvested and gently pressed, before the clarified juice underwent fermentation in both stainless steel tanks and old French oak barrels. Post fermentation, the wine was kept on yeast lees with periodic stirring to introduce complexity and texture.

Expressive aromatics of ripe lime and peach are a prelude to an intensely fresh and juicy palate with a sweet, salted core of citrus fruits providing a mouthwatering finish."
