Winery notes (2025 Vintage)

"At Miraval, music runs through our vines. Studio by Miraval Rosé is our tribute to the legendary recording studio on our estate, where artists like Pink Floyd, AC/DC, and The Cranberries once found their rhythm among the olive trees and lavender fields.

Crafted with care in the South of France, this Méditerranée rosé wine is a blend of Cinsault, Grenache, Rolle, and Tibouren. It's fresh, expressive, and effortlessly elegant - with notes of wild berries, citrus zest, and delicate florals, all balanced by a crisp, mineral finish.

We designed it to pair beautifully with seafood, light salads, and Mediterranean fare; the kind of meals best enjoyed al fresco, with music in the air and friends at the table. Studio by Miraval Rosé is more than just a wine, it's our way of bottling the creative spirit of this extraordinary place.

Fresh and complex, with vibrant aromas of red berries, citrus zest, and a touch of white peach, accompanied by subtle floral notes. Lively and refreshing, with a balance of tangy fruit and a touch of salinity. Flavours of wild strawberries, raspberries, and citrus, complemented by a smooth, iodized finish. The wine is complex yet easy to drink, with a crisp acidity and a pleasing roundness."
