"Dressed in bright red with a regal purple edge, Estate Syrah 2023 exudes aromas of red plum and dark cherry cola accentuated by hints of smoke, pepper, and nutmeg. The palate unfurls with ripe boysenberry and raspberry fruit, nuanced by undertones of chocolate, and toasted vanilla oak. A sumptuous wine in harmonious balance Estate Syrah 2023 culminates in a long and lingering, savoury finish."

"Toasted hazelnut, peanut shell, pepper, Turkish apricot, blueberry and ripe raspberry. Medium-bodied, fleshy, sooty tannin, crushed herb and a subtle green character set among spicy blue fruits and cocoa, closing with a dry wheaty finish solid length. No mistaking the grape variety here, and offers ease of drinking with a fair amount of complexity. Good."
