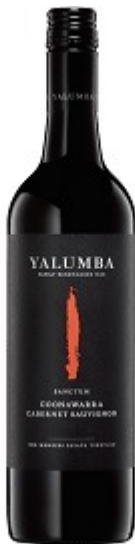

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TASTING NOTES

Sanctum remains a standout in Yalumba's impressive range and a consistent favourite of ours. Drawing on the estate's long mastery of Cabernet and the renowned terroir of Coonawarra, it delivers all the hallmarks of the region with confidence and polish.

What makes it even more compelling is the value. To find this level of pedigree and regional character for under \$20 is genuinely remarkable.

The previous 2021 vintage of this was Yalumba's most awarded wine in the history of the company, which is pretty remarkable when you consider they have been around for over 175 years! Unfortunately, that vintage is now sold out, but the good news is, the 2022 is every bit as good, and we expect this will do just as well in the upcoming wine shows again this year.

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Offering insane value for money at this deal price, Sanctum comes off Yalumba's Menzies Vineyard that lies in the heart of Coonawarra, the holy grail of all Cabernet purists, and for over 35 years has produced some of the region's best.

Winery notes (2022 Vintage)

"Yalumba's Menzies Estate Vineyard lies in the heart of Coonawarra on the famous terra rossa soil over limestone. This valuable patch of land is the holy grail of all Cabernet purists; just 2 kilometres wide and 20 kilometres long, with soil vivid red in colour. For more than 30 years Yalumba has made wines of excellence with grapes from this vineyard, earning its place in the inner Sanctum of Coonawarra.

Good rainfall in late winter and early spring replenished the soils and gave the vines plenty of available water to start the growing season. A mild and wet spring kept moisture levels up to the growing vines. Summer and autumn were mild and dry, ideal for ripening the grapes which were harvested at the perfect ripeness in April.

Deep crimson in colour. Intense aromas of blueberries, violets, dark red plums and dark berries. Rich and vibrant, the wine bursts with fresh, intense red and blue fruits, the palate is structured with the mid-palate balanced by fine, long tannins. Matured for 10 months in older French oak hogsheads and barriques."

"This immediately appeals to the nose, showing blackcurrant, dark plum, clove, subtle tobacco, and assorted nut aromas. The palate is equally appealing with excellent weight and delicate texture, beautifully supported by polished tannins, making it sturdy yet balanced with a lengthy, delectable finish. At its best: now to 2032."

"Rich and dark in colour that matches the bouquet - rich and dark fruited with blackberry and roasted plums, there's a black olive note just before the spice and smoke of wood layers in. Dry on the palate with the impact of tannins and acidity biting first, these are contrasted by the fleshy core fruits. The wine has a bold muscley frame and fleshy chewy core. It's balanced and well made with a decent finish. Best drinking from day of purchase through 2030+."

"Yalumba has owned the Menzies vineyard in Coonawarra since 1987 and produces an archetypal Coonawarra cabernet sauvignon under the Menzies label, a homage to Australia's longest serving prime minister. This is the third release of this wine which is the little brother of the flagship Yalumba Menzies Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon, displaying all the brambly dark fruitedness, structure and texture for which Coonawarra is famous.

A deep, dark, plummy red in appearance. Lifted and leafy aromas, along with blackberry, ferrous earth, dried herbs and pencil shavings. Firm, grippy and structured in the mouth. Cassis, dark cherry and spice flavours hit the palate first, then some seriously grippy and textured tannins kick in and partner with bright acidity to deliver length and mouth-feel."

"Deep, rich purple, even colour throughout. This has a robust bouquet with aromas of cassis, blueberry, plum, tobacco and an amalgam of spice. Full-bodied, aromas of cassis and blueberry entwined with red plum, unfolding tobacco, nutmeg and star anise. The rich palate is packed with velvety tannins, framing the succulent fruit and unfolding mineral hints. Enlivening acidity provides balance and length to the rich mineral palate and lends a sustained, enticing finish. This Cabernet Sauvignon is well-structured, appealing, and represents a sense of place. Match with braised brisket or steak over the next 8+ years. Fermented to 14% alc. Vegan friendly."
