"In the same way that the Glover family's Zephyr feels like a brand for modern times, so this Riesling with its bright lime-cordial aromas, lowish alcohol and subtly off-dry nature (12 g/l) is well suited to modern tastes and lifestyles. Made from the Brawn single vineyard in Marlborough's highly regarded Dillons Point sub-region, this is an easy-going, uncomplicated and zesty take on the variety. The Opaoa River, which runs to the south of the family vineyard, is apparently home to scores of whitebait, a local delicacy that the Glovers say is perfect with a glass of their Zephyr Riesling. Sounds idyllic."
