Winery notes (2017 Vintage)

"Perfumed with lovely aromatics, there is a range of complexed fruit notes of darker berry fruit, some spice, savoury tones and dried herbs. The 2017 has a silky and lush texture fruit power, is concentrated yet finely balanced with fine tannins throughout and long in flavour. A more classic vintage for us.

Vinified using open fermenters, hand plunging, natural yeasts, and 11 months in French oak - 15 % new - before racking and settling in tank for a further 4 months. Fermentation was carried out using de-stemmed fruit including the addition of 25% whole bunches, plus several tanks of 100% whole bunch fruit fermentation. No filtration or fining, deposits may form. Organically grown, made and certified."
